Oh hurray. Lots of healing this last month and I'm pretty much on my feet most days. This means that I got to sing a lot. Ahhh, my favorite thing.

Cindy and I started out by going to Glenna Shepherd's church in Pleasant Hill, TN. Do you all remember Glenna? I've told a lot of stories about our friendship over the years, but you might know her because she produced several of my CDs including the Christmas one and Songs of Praise. She is pastoring a United Church of Christ (UCC) here in Tennessee now, about 2 hours from us. This is a fascinating church. Most of the people there live on the same grounds in a center for retired pastors and missionaries from the UCC and the Disciples of Christ denominations. Both of those denominations have long since dealt with full inclusion of women and of the LGBTQ community. Some of these wonderful people shared their stories with us. One woman went to Hiroshima as a medical missionary in 1948. Another man who served in South Africa in the 40s and 50s told us how it took 28 days each way to get there on a freighter. It was a humbling place to go to minister.

Cindy and I did special music in the morning service – a song I wrote in which I sing and she plays her clarinet. After Sunday lunch everyone came back for a concert. I started out thinking I might tone it down a bit for the older crowd, but they were all in to it – laughing at my stories, crying at my songs, and then it was time for Cindy to share her story. She actually tried to back out for a second – she felt like they couldn't possibly be interested in her testimony about drugs, alcohol and coming out. BUT, she was wrong. They were enthralled and the best listeners ever. There were so many tears afterward that they shared tissues and one man told her that he'd never gone forward at an altar call, but he would to pray with her.

We were still basking in all that love, when it was time for me to leave for California to share at the All Nations Gathering at Glory Center. They were doing a sort of Double Jubilee celebration of both the 50 year ministry of MCC, the first church dedicated to ministry to the LGBTQ

community, and the beginning of the 50 year anniversary of the of the Jesus Movement. The conference started Thursday evening and continued all day Friday and Saturday until Sunday morning. Since I was part of both of those movements of the Holy Spirit, Rev. Sandy Turnbull was kind enough to invite me to sing at every. So, I got to sing "Jesus Music" with my guitar for several services. Then as a big plus, the wonderful Joe Hogue and their praise band learned some of my songs about coming out. My friend Connie was able to come down from the Bay Area, and Bea and Sandy made me feel at home in their guestroom. On top of all that there were moving messages, Spirit filled services, tender prayers, and the magnificent ministry of Marvin Matthews. I got to catch up with Chuck Smith jr who so graciously took us to Israel a few years ago. It was one of those blessings that keeps you buoyed up for months. The theme? "Do it Again, Lord!"
