If you're a dog owner and don't know where to take your beloved pet so you can grab a bite to eat, we've got you covered. We've sniffed out some of the best dog-friendly patios in Calgary for you.

Here are some dog-friendly patios to check out this summer.

### **Sandstone Lounge**

The Sandstone Lounge is located within the Hyatt Regency hotel. Check out their outdoor patio for a great view of downtown Calgary, especially all lit up at night.
