Clinic Format

Scott will have a white board to illustrate his points if necessary. Participants will be able to click on a virtual hand raise to ask questions. During the clinic they can choose to be seen in the Zoom gallery or not.

We suggest participants spend time beforehand getting comfortable with Zoom. Also, Jenny will offer a half hour Zoom meeting the evening before the clinic. She will help

you figure things out so that nothing takes away from your experience on the day.
