

*Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the **latter times** some shall **depart from the faith**, giving heed to **seducing spirits**, and **doctrines of devils**; 1 Timothy 4:1*

*And many **false prophets** shall rise, and shall **deceive many**. Matthew 24:11*

*For there shall arise false Christs, and **false prophets**, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if [it were] possible, they **shall deceive** the very elect. Matthew 24:24*
