Glyn Bailey & the Beholden Release Debut Album

Two years in the making, the new 10 track album '2059' by Glyn Bailey & the Beholden will be available from June 1st

When compared with previous Glyn Bailey albums, it's easy to hear there's been a conscious effort to circumvent the usual 'stylistic' musical approach ... the result is something not so easily pigeonholed. The 'Beholden' band sound is old fashioned yet strangely futuristic in both concept and execution.

With Glyn's longstanding musical partner & collaborator Phil Senior still handling guitar duties, they have now been joined full-time by Lizz Beahan, who contributes some beautiful violin & vocal parts. This core trio are preparing for live summer performances as 'The Beholden'. The recording sessions for **2059** were completed with help from members of Glyn's previous band *The Many Splendid Things*, together with contributions from a couple of other local musicians.



Of the album's overriding concept, Bailey says he likes to think of it as "*An imaginary tipping point, where the past & future collide to create a perfect moment, in which all ideas come together to make something timeless & impossible ... Like we're holding a distorted mirror up to the Steampunk tradition!*"

Themes of lost treasure (*78rpm*), a haunted dancehall (*Dancefloor* - inspired by the Blackpool Tower Ballroom), the shackles of human existence (*Chains*), the belief that we are all cosmically connected (*Stars*), and a version of Slade's 70's glam rock stomper *Coz I Luv U* combine with others to make this work something special.

The CD version is available exclusively from the artist's website, with online downloads via iTunes and all the usual major retailers. Production and mastering were all handled Stateside by Dave Archer of Last Riff Studios, Cincinnati, USA
