

## The James Bond Award

The “James Bond” Award has been donated by Don and Martha Neblett in honor of CH Sugar Hollow’s James Bond and his exceptional accomplishments of 1991. No dog in our club’s history has done the kind of winning that JB accomplished in 1991. He was ranked in the top five Labrador Retrievers in the country in both Labrador Quarterly systems. He finished his championship, beating top-winning specials for Best of Breed. He won 53 Best of Breeds and 19 Group placements.

In the past, to be eligible for this award the dog had to have been ranked in the top 20 Labradors in both systems of the Labrador Quarterly. Because no dog in our club has won the trophy after it was first donated, the Nebletts graciously offered to change the requirements so the trophy can be presented. Beginning in 2014, the trophy will be presented to the Labrador Retriever with the most Group placements/Best of Breed awards during the calendar year. If no dog has achieved Group/BOB awards, the trophy will go to the Champion Labrador with the most Grand Champion points won during the year.
