

Please Note:

With the cooperation of Mother Nature, we will run this show outdoors. If weather dictates otherwise, we will post an indoor schedule in the barns and on Facebook.

It is our intention to comply with all regulations regarding social distancing and facial coverings that are in effect at the time of the show. The six foot guidelines will be important to observe. Everyone over two years of age, not mounted, **must** wear a mask. We request that Exhibitors and Trainers do not congregate in close quarters around the in-gate areas.

If you are not feeling well, we will appreciate it if you stay home.

Trainers are responsible to taking temperatures of all people in their group each day. **DAILY SIGN IN SHEETS WILL BE PROVIDED AND SHOULD BE RETURNED TO THE SHOW OFFICE EACH DAY.**

New horse wash areas are located on the Thruway side of the indoor arena. Please use the barn entrance closest to your stalls. Please do not congregate in the barn aisles. **MASKS REQUIRED IN BARN ALSO.**

Those adjusting jumps in the schooling areas are asked to wear gloves. Please spray the jump cups with the provided disinfectant after using them.

SATURDAY Entries can be submitted by texting the horse name, owner trainer and rider names and class numbers to Liz Pinto at 973.479.1393.

A single representative of the barn can then bring the paper copies to the entry tent. We are trying to keep direct contact to a minimum.

SUNDAY Entries can be emailed by scanning or photographing to **naomishorshow@gmail.com**. You can also use horseshowing.com to enter.

Adds and scratches can be texted to 973.479.1393 or 315.346.1933. Please include your horse name and back #, rider name and class #s.

Braiding is optional in all classes. No conformation in pony divisions. In Rated classes, you must trot a circle on a loose rein for the jog.

Directions

From The West: Use Exit 46 from Rt 90. Take Rt. 390 North to Lehigh Station Road. Turn right. Follow to Clover St, Rt 65, & turn right onto Clover. Take the 1st left after crossing over Rt 90 onto Canfield Road. Take the 1st left onto So Wilmarth Road and follow to end to Lehman Farms.

From The East: Use Exit 45 from Rt 90. Take Rt. 490 to Bushnell's Basin. Turn right onto Rt 96, left onto Thornell Road, left onto West Bloomfield Road, cross over Rt 90 and immediately turn right onto Canfield Road. Go straight into Mendon Ponds Park. First right onto So Wilmarth Road and follow to end to Lehman Farms.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Every class offered herein on Sunday which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
2. STABLING: Limited Stabling Is Available at Lehman Farms. Stall Fees: \$80.00 for the weekend for permanent box stalls with doors and clay floors. . FOR STALL RESERVATIONS: Contact **Gail Miller** 585-721-9415. **Initial Straw Bedding Included.**
3. No person shall be allowed to ride in an Amateur Class who does not have a current USEF amateur certification or complete the appropriate paper work to apply for one in the show office. All Pony, Junior and Children's Pony Hunters must show current measurement cards or be measured at the show. **USEF and USHJA memberships available on line at www.usef.org for Sunday show.**
4. USHJA Horse Registration #s are required for all horses/ponies at the Sat & Sun shows. **Safe Sport Compliance for all adult owners, riders, trainers & coaches. Microchips Required for Sun Show for all horses except Leadline and Opportunity.**
5. All prize money will be paid in the show office or credited to the exhibitor's bill.
6. There will be a \$30.00 surcharge added to all checks returned by the bank. A billing charge of \$25.00 will be added to all accounts not settled in full at the show.
7. The outdoor show rings are each 125'X275'. IndoorRings 75' X 175' and 80'X 235'. All have sand footing. Lunging areas available in many locations with grass footing.
8. Lehman Farms, the show manager and/or show management take no responsibility for loss, injury or damage to horses, exhibitors, equipment and anyone connected thereto.
9. Each horse/rider is required to pay a \$35.00 EMT/Insurance Fee at each show. On Saturday & Sunday all horses are required to pay a \$2.00 USHJA Zone Fee and \$23.00 USEF fee per day.
10. Schooling will be available the afternoon and evening prior to the first day of the show for horses entering the show. **A \$35.00 schooling fee will be charged if no entry is made.**
11. Full payment, a signed check or credit card info must be left with the secretary before numbers are issued.
12. **Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, and Combined Driving Competitions at the advanced level, Dressage, Reining, and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions, and Combined Driving Competitions, upon payment of a \$45 show pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule; 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk/trot; (Exception: Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.**
13. **Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardians(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of a device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.**

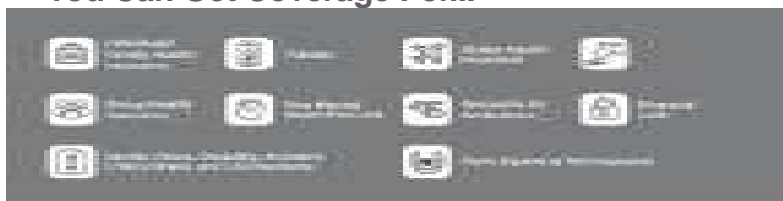

RULES GOVERNING THE AWARDS

1. To be eligible for High Score Awards, all horses and ponies must be nominated and the person(s) in whose name(s) the horse or pony is showing, or the child who is showing in horsemanship classes, must be a current member of the Syracuse Chapter PHA. No points will count towards the High Score Awards until after the dues and nominations are received by the PHA Secretary.

2. THE SYRACUSE PHA MEDAL EQUITATION CLASSES

Unless noted otherwise, all classes to be shown over a course of not less than 6 obstacles, which may include one combination including an oxer and one change of direction. Fences for Junior Hunter Riders 3'6" &/or 3'3"; fences for Children's Hunters Horses and Adult Riders 3'; fences for Children's Hunters Large Ponies 2'6". Small-Medium Ponies 2', Pre-Child & Pre-Adult Horses 2'6", Pre-Child Ponies 2'. Medal Class USEF Tests for Jr Hunter Riders 1-17; All others Tests 1-7. Testing is optional in all classes and/or the Judge may elect to include one or more tests in the original course. Every Member show is required to offer a Jr, Children's & Adult PHA Medal Class if they offer the corresponding Hunter Divisions. Other medals are optional. Management may offer a separate class for riders of Children's Hunter Ponies and/or Pre-Children's Ponies. Horses and riders showing in the Junior Hunter Division, may not enter the Children's Medal at the same show. Children's Pony riders may enter the USEF Pony Medal. **Additional rules explained in the current Syracuse PHA Rule Book.**

3. PRE-GREEN HUNTERS - 3' & 3'3" Green Hunters

Open to all horses and ponies in their first or second consecutive year of showing that have never shown in classes where the fences exceed 3'3" at Regular Member USEF or Equine Canada Horse Shows and/or PHA Rated Divisions. Horses may not show in any classes at this show where the fences exceed 3'3".

4. PRE-ADULT & PRE-CHILDREN'S HUNTERS

Open to all jr riders on horses or ponies &/or adult riders who have USEF amateur certification. The same horse/ rider combination may not show in any rated division or classes at the same show. Fences 2'6" for horses and 2' for ponies. Any rider showing in any division/class at the same show where the fence height exceeds 3' cannot show in the Pre-Children's/Pre-Adult Hunters (Including the under saddle). Any horse/rider combination who has previously shown over fences exceeding 3' shall no longer be eligible for the pre-childrens/pre-adult hunter divisions.
