GENERAL INFORMATION

1. STABLING: Stall Fees: \$85.00 for permanent box stalls **paid by April 4th**. Stalls paid after April 4th \$100.00. FOR STALL RESERVATIONS:— Naomi Blumenthal at 315.436.1933 or nblumenthal@twcny.rr.com or fax 315.682.9416. Horses not purchasing stalls will be charged a \$50.00 grounds fee for the show.
2. The management reserves the right to change the order of classes before or during the show and to combine or cancel classes as it deems necessary.
3. All prize money will be paid in the show office or deducted from entry bills.
4. An open check or deposit must be left in the show office when numbers are picked up. Exhibitors can settle their accounts at checkout after they are done competing. There will be a \$100.00 surcharge added to all checks returned by the bank. A billing charge of \$35.00 will be added to all accounts not settled in full at the show. **Credit Cards Accepted with a 5% convenience fee added.**
5. The Spring Premier Horse Show principals and the show manager take no responsibility for loss, injury or damage to horses, exhibitors, equipment and anyone connected thereto.
6. There will be a \$35.00 fee per day/night for every vehicle parked on the grounds in which someone is sleeping. This fee is charged even if the vehicle is not using a hookup.
7. Each rider will be charged a \$35.00 EMT/Insurance fee.
8. All fees will be refunded if entries are cancelled on or before April 4, 2018. There will be a \$25.00 office charge for all scratches after April 4th. There will be no refunds on stalls after April 4th, but stalls may be applied to another horse.
9. Junior Exhibitors are those who have not reached their 18th birthday on 12/1/17. Amateur Exhibitors must have reached their 18th birthday by 12/1/17. Any adult individual who accepts remuneration for riding, driving, training, showing or schooling horses, teaching or conducting clinics is considered a professional for purposes of this competition.
10. The Horse Show is held in the Coliseum on the NYS Fairgrounds in Syracuse, NY
Exhibitors from the West should use Exit 39 on the New York State Thruway (Route 90). Then follow Route 690 East to the Fairgrounds.
Exhibitors from the East can use Exit 34A or Exit 39 on the New York State Thruway From Exit 34A follow Route 481 South to Route 690 West to the Fairgrounds. Exit 39 is closer to the Fairgrounds and is recommended.
Exhibitors from the North follow Route 81 South. Follow signs to Route 690 West and exit Route 690 West at the Fairgrounds.
Exhibitors from the South follow Route 81 North to Route 690 West. Use the Fairgrounds Exit from 690.

PLEASE NOTE:

The following Health Requirements **MUST** be met by all horses

A proof of a current Rabies Inoculation administered within 12 months of coming to the grounds must be presented for each horse.

HORSES STABLED IN NEW YORK STATE:

Must present a **Negative Coggins** Test certificate dated in 2017 or 2018

HORSES STABLED OUTSIDE NY STATE:

Must present a **Negative Coggins** Test certificate-dated SINCE 4/16/17 and a Health Certificate-dated within 30 days of your arrival in NY State
