RULES GOVERNING THE AWARDS

1. To be eligible for High Score Awards, all horses and ponies must be nominated and the person(s) in whose name(s) the horse or pony is showing, or the child who is showing in horsemanship classes, must be a current member of the Syracuse Chapter PHA. No points will count towards the High Score Awards until after the dues and nominations are received by the PHA Secretary.

2. THE SYRACUSE PHA MEDAL EQUITATION CLASSES

Unless noted otherwise, all classes to be shown over a course of not less than 6 obstacles, which may include one combination including an oxer and one change of direction. Fences for Junior Hunter Riders 3'6" &/or 3'3"; fences for Children's Hunters Horses and Adult Riders 3'; fences for Children's Hunters Large Ponies 2'6", Small-Medium Ponies 2', Pre-Child & Pre-Adult Horses 2'6", Pre-Child Ponies 2'. Medal Class USEF Tests for Jr Hunter Riders 1-17; All others Tests 1-7. Testing is optional in all classes and/or the Judge may elect to include one or more tests in the original course. Every Member show is required to offer a Jr, Children's & Adult PHA Medal Class if they offer the corresponding Hunter Divisions. Other medals are optional. Management may offer a separate class for riders of Children's Hunter Ponies and/or Pre-Children's Ponies. Horses and riders showing in the Junior Hunter Division, may not enter the Children's Medal at the same show. Children's Pony riders may enter the USEF Pony Medal. **Additional rules explained in the current Syracuse PHA Rule Book.**

3. PRE-GREEN HUNTERS - 3' & 3'3" Green Hunters

Open to all horses and ponies in their first or second consecutive year of showing that have never shown in classes where the fences exceed 3'3" at Regular Member USEF or Equine Canada Horse Shows and/or PHA Rated Divisions. Horses may not show in any classes at this show where the fences exceed 3'3".

4. PRE-ADULT & PRE-CHILDREN'S HUNTERS

Open to all jr riders on horses or ponies &/or adult riders who have USEF amateur certification. The same horse/ rider combination may not show in any rated division or classes at the same show. Fences 2'6" for horses and 2' for ponies. Any rider showing in any division/class at the same show where the fence height exceeds 3' cannot show in the Pre-Children's/Pre-Adult Hunters (Including the under saddle). Any horse/rider combination who has previously shown over fences exceeding 3' shall no longer be eligible for the pre-childrens/pre-adult hunter divisions.

From The West: Use Exit 46 from Rt 90. Take Rt. 390 North to Lehigh Station Road. Turn right. Follow to Clover St, Rt 65, & turn right onto Clover. Take the 1st left after crossing over Rt 90 onto Canfield Road. Take the 1st left onto So Wilmarth Road and follow to end to Lehman Farms.

From The East: Use Exit 45 from Rt 90. Take Rt. 490 to Bushnell's Basin. Turn right onto Rt 96, left onto Thornell Road, left onto West Bloomfield Road, cross over Rt 90 and immediately turn right onto Canfield Road. Go straight into Mendon Ponds Park. First right onto So Wilmarth Road and follow to end to Lehman Farms.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Every class offered herein on Sunday which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
2. STABLING: Limited Stabling Is Available at Lehman Farms. Stall Fees: \$80.00 for the weekend for permanent box stalls with doors. FOR STALL RESERVATIONS: Contact **Gail Miller** 585-721-9415. **Initial Straw Bedding Included.**
3. No person shall be allowed to ride in an Amateur Class who does not have a current USEF amateur certification or complete the appropriate paper work to apply for one in the show office. All Pony, Junior and Children's Pony Hunters must show current measurement cards or be measured at the show. **USEF and USHJA memberships available on line at www.usef.org for Sunday show. Print a card and bring it to the show.**
4. USHJA Horse Registration #s are required for all horses/ponies at the Sunday show. **Safe Sport Compliance for all adult owners, riders, trainers & coaches. Microchips Required for Sunday Show for all horses except Leadline and Opportunity.**
5. The management reserves the right to change the order of classes before or during the show and to combine or cancel classes or divisions with fewer than four entries.
6. All prize money will be paid in the show office or credited to the exhibitor's bill.
7. There will be a \$30.00 surcharge added to all checks returned by the bank. A billing charge of \$25.00 will be added to all accounts not settled in full at the show.
8. The indoor show ring is approximately 80' X 235'. Indoor Schooling 75' X 175'. Both have sand footing.
9. Lehman Farms, the show manager and/or show management take no responsibility for loss, injury or damage to horses, exhibitors, equipment and anyone connected thereto.
10. Each horse/rider is required to pay a \$30.00 EMT/Insurance Fee at each show. On Sunday all horses are required to pay a \$2.00 USHJA Zone Fee and \$23.00 USEF fees
11. Schooling will be available the afternoon and evening prior to the first day of the show for horses entering the show. **A \$35.00 schooling fee will be charged if no entry is made.**
12. Full payment or a signed check must be left with the secretary before numbers are issued.
13. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibi-tions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes. 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
14. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. *The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation.* Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

North American League for year end finals.



In order for riders to receive credit they must be a current member. Membership is valid for the calendar year and entitles a rider to show one or more horses in any of the accredited classes.

Finals are held at the Pennsylvania National Horse Show. Members will receive newsletters with standings and upcoming events.

Adult Amateur Hunter: To be shown by riders 18 years and older who hold current USEF Amateur certification. Ponies may be shown in this division, with suitability taken into consideration by the judge. Riders may not compete in any other classes at the same competition where the fence height exceeds 3'6", except Adult Amateur Jumper and USEF Talent Search. Horses may be shown by a different rider in any other division or class at the same competition. Riders may cross enter between the Adult Amateur Hunter and the Amateur Owner section if the rider owns the horse he or she is showing in the Adult Amateur section. Riders can cross enter between the Amateur Owner 3'3" and 3'6", but horses may not cross enter between any Adult Amateur and Amateur Owner Hunter sections at the same show. If the section is held in one day a maximum of four classes may be offered. If the section is held over two days a maximum of five classes may be offered. This division may be split into three age groups – Adult Amateurs 18-35 and Adult Amateurs 36-49 and Adult Amateurs 50 and over. If there are less than three entries in one Adult section if offered split it may be combined with another Adult Amateur section. If there is only one section of Adult Amateurs it may be combined with Children's Hunter Horse section. Fence height to be 3' with spreads not to exceed the fence height. Horses or Ponies not to jog.

Children's Hunter: To be shown by a junior exhibitor. Rider may not cross enter into any other class at the same competition where the fences exceed 3'. (Exception: Children's Jumper, Pony Jumpers, USHJA National Hunter Derby and Equitation Classes where the fences do not exceed 3'6"). A rider on a Children's Hunter Horse may cross enter into the Pony Hunter Division or the Green Pony Hunter Division at the same competition, but a rider on a Children's Hunter Pony may NOT cross enter into the Pony Hunter Division or Green Pony Hunter at the same competition. Ponies showing in the Children's Pony Division may not cross enter into the Regular Pony Hunter Divisions or the Green Pony Hunter Division at the same competition. In the under saddle if a rider has two or more horses entered, at least one horse is ridden by the original rider, and the additional horse(s) entered may be ridden by another junior rider, provided the additional junior rider(s) do(es) not compete in classes where the fences exceed 3'6" at the same competition. Horses may not cross enter into the Junior Hunter section at the same competition. If the section is held in one day, a maximum of 4 classes may be offered, if the section is held over two days, a maximum of 5 classes may be offered. The Children's Hunter section may be split into four sections, points will be accrued separately for each section, and Zone Awards will be given for each section. The sections are to be: Children's Hunter Horse 14 & Under, Children's Hunter Horse 15-17, Children's Hunter Large Pony and Children's Hunter Small/Medium Pony. If there are more than 25 in any one section then that section may be split into Sections A and B. If there are less than 3 horses entered in the Children's Hunter Horse section, then they may be combined and judged with the Adult Amateur Hunter section. If there are less than 3 ponies in the Children's Hunter Small/Medium Pony or Children's Hunter Large Pony, then the classes may be combined and judged together. Fence heights are to be 3' for Children's Horses, 2'6" for Children's Large Pony, and 2' for Children's Small/Medium Pony, with spreads not to exceed fence height. Horses or Ponies not to jog.
