## **Please Note:**

Those adjusting jumps in the schooling areas are asked to wear gloves. Please spray the jump cups with the provided disinfectant after using them.

A single representative of the barn can then bring the paper work to the office. We are trying to keep direct contact to a minimum.

**Adds and scratches** can be texted to 973.479.1393 or 315.436.1933. Please include your horse name and back #, rider name and class #s.

**Braiding is optional in all classes.**

No more than two exhibitors will be permitted in the show office at one time.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. STABLING: Stall Fees: \$95.00 for permanent box stalls paid by October 2. Stalls paid after October 2 \$105.00. FOR STALL RESERVATIONS:— Naomi Blumenthal at 315.436.1933 or nblumenthal@twcny.rr.com. Horses not purchasing stalls will be charged a \$65.00 grounds fee for the show.
2. The management reserves the right to change the order of classes before or during the show and to combine or cancel classes as it deems necessary.
3. All stalls should be paid in full with a check, money order or cash prior to October 8<sup>th</sup>. Payments will be deposited upon receipt. An open check or deposit must be left in the show office when numbers are picked up. Exhibitors should settle their accounts at checkout after they are done competing. There will be a \$100.00 surcharge added to all checks returned by the bank. A billing charge of \$35.00 will be added to all accounts not settled in full at the show.
4. The Fall Finale Horse Show principals and the show manager take no responsibility for loss, injury or damage to horses, exhibitors, equipment and anyone connected thereto.
5. There will be a \$35.00 fee per day/night for every vehicle parked on the grounds in which someone is sleeping. This fee is charged even if the vehicle is not using a hookup.
6. Each rider will be charged a \$35.00 EMT/Insurance fee.
7. All fees will be refunded if entries are cancelled on or before October 10, 2020. There will be a \$25.00 office charge for all scratches after October 1<sup>st</sup>. There will be no refunds on stalls. Once the show has started, horses which are not shown in classes in which they are entered forfeit the fees unless a scratch is made in the horse show office prior to the start of the class.
8. Junior Exhibitors are those who have not reached their 18th birthday on 12/1/19. Amateur Exhibitors must have reached their 18th birthday by 12/1/19. Any adult individual who accepts remuneration for riding, driving, training, showing or schooling horses, teaching or conducting clinics is considered a professional for purposes of this competition.
9. The Horse Show is held in the Coliseum on the NYS Fairgrounds in Syracuse, NY

### PLEASE NOTE:

**A proof of a current Rabies Inoculation administered within 12 months of coming to the grounds must be presented for each horse.**

#### **HORSES STABLED IN NEW YORK STATE:**

Must present a **Negative Coggins** Test certificate dated in 2019 or 2020. Please attach a legible copy to your entry blank.

#### **HORSES STABLED OUTSIDE NY STATE:**

Must present a **Negative Coggins** Test certificate-dated SINCE 10/6/19. Please attach a legible copy to your entry blank.

#### **AND:**

a current Health Certificate-dated within 30 days of your arrival in N.Y. State-from **your local veterinarian.**

#### **CANADA:**

Health Requirements for **our purposes** are the same as for horses stabled outside New York State.
