

What do you need to do?

After your physician has received the test results, Interpace Diagnostics will handle the insurance claim submission. Many commercial insurance carriers cover our tests, as they are deemed reasonable and necessary.

You will receive a statement, or Explanation of Benefits (EOB), from your insurance carrier. **This EOB is not a bill;** do not pay the amount on this statement.

After Interpace Diagnostics receives a response from your insurance plan, you will receive a letter from us accompanied by an application to participate in the COMPASS* Program. All patients are encouraged to apply so that our experienced staff can provide information tailored to your unique situation.

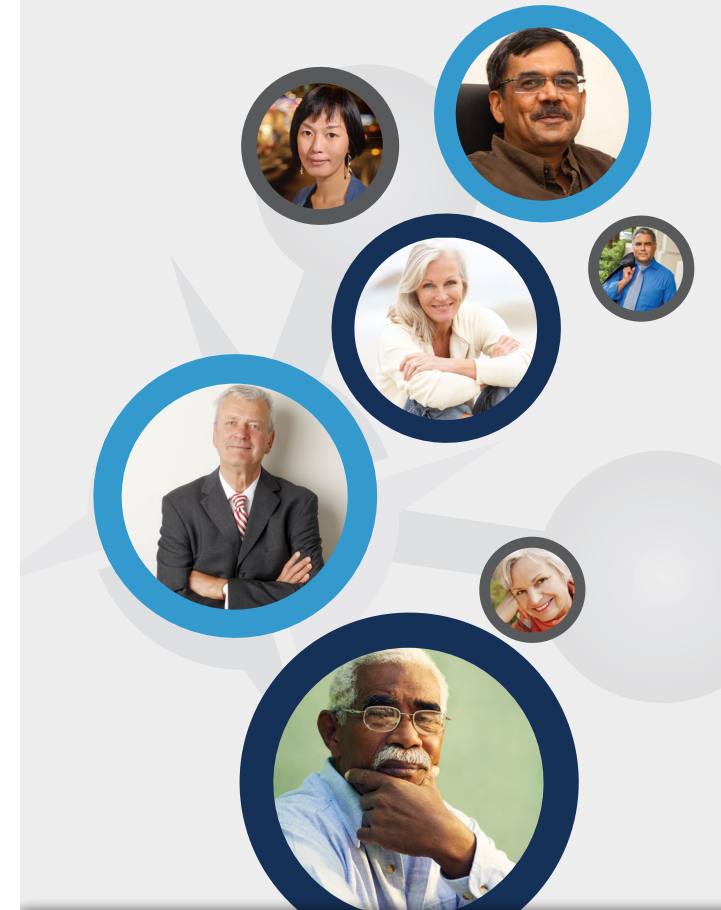

COMPASS Program

Compassionate Assistance Program:
Financial Options for Patients



About the COMPASS Program

At Interpace Diagnostics, we are committed to providing patients with access to personalized medicine, regardless of their personal financial situation.

Financial Assistance

Interpace Diagnostics offers needs-based assistance to patients, accounting for factors such as income and family unit size, based on guidelines provided by US Department of Health and Human Services (www.hhs.gov).

- For patients who fall below 200% of the federal poverty level and qualify for the program, testing is provided at no charge.
- For patients who meet or exceed 200% of the federal poverty level and qualify for the program based on financial need, the estimated patient responsibility ranges from \$100 to \$300.
- According to median household incomes, most qualified individuals would be responsible to pay \$100.

Payment Plans

For patients who do not qualify, payment plans with 0% financing for 36 months are available.

*COMPASS is not available to patients covered by Medicare, Medicaid, or any other government program, or where the program is restricted or prohibited by contractual obligation, or federal or state law. COMPASS is only available to patients within the United States.

Examples of Patients who qualify for the COMPASS Program

Case 1



Married man, 2 children (family of 4)

Family income (yearly)	\$45,000
Estimated patient responsibility	\$0

Case 2



Single woman, 1 child (family of 2)

Family income (yearly)	\$65,000
Estimated patient responsibility	\$100

Case 3



Single man, 0 children (family of 1)

Family income (yearly)	\$49,000
Estimated patient responsibility	\$100

Case 4



Married woman, 1 child (family of 3)

Family income (yearly)	\$201,000
Estimated patient responsibility	\$300
