a). What covenant is talked about here and where did we see that in the Scriptures?

b). What then do we learn about the inheritance from these verses?

2). Read Galatians 3:16 – What do we learn here about Christ?

a). Where do we see Christ referred to as a ‘Seed’ elsewhere?

b). What and when do both of these references to ‘Seed’ have to do with?

3). Read Psalm 2:5-7 – What are these verses about?

a). What in particular do we learn from v7?

4). Read Galatians 3:29 – 4:7 – What is the connection between 4:4 and the answer to the last question?

a). What do we learn for ourselves from 3:29?

b). What do we learn from 4:1-2?

c). How was this to apply to Abraham's physical descendants at the Lord's first advent?

d). How is this to apply to Abraham's spiritual descendants as a result of the Lord's first advent?

e). What is the process to bring us to maturity and when will this be brought to completion?

5). Are we given a precise timing for when 'the fullness of the time' would come?

a). Where do we see it, and what is the time given?

b). What is the only reason that Christ was born of a woman?

c). How do you think this should impact how we should view what we call 'Christmas'?

6). What connection is there between the end of the OT and the beginning of the New?
