a). What is laid out for us in the first 52 verses of John's Gospel?

b). How is this same subject presented to us through the OT prophets and which Scripture did we look at that shows us this?

c). Read 1 Peter 1:9-12 – What does Peter have to say about this?

d). Read Hebrews 1:1-2 – What does the writer of Hebrews have to say about this?

2). What are the 7 OT quotations found in Hebrews Chapter 1 and where in the OT would we find them?

a). Looking at these OT quotations – firstly, what do they tell us about Jesus?

b). Secondly, What, do they tell us about angels?

c). Why is the Lord anointed with the oil of gladness more than His companions?

d). What does this first Chapter of Hebrews confirm for us and where did we also see this presented in Colossians?

3). Read Hebrews 2:1 – What exactly does this verse teach us?

a). Read 2 Peter 1:12-16 – What is Peter’s focus in these verses and why is this so important to him?

b). Why is it so important that we continually keep the things we have heard in the forefront of our mind?

4). Read Hebrews 2:2 and Hebrews 4:2 – Who is referenced in these verses and what do we learn from them?

a). Read Hebrews 2:3-4 – What exactly does ‘so great salvation’ mean to you?

b). What is the warning we are given at the beginning of v3?

c). What does it mean to ‘neglect so great salvation’?

d). Where do we find an echo of this warning in the Revelation and how is it played out there?

e). Look at the second half of v3 and v4 – What do we learn here?
