Study Questions

1). Read Matthew 23:13 – By way of review – exactly what had Israel’s religious leaders ‘shut up’?

a). How did they manage to do this?

c). What would the nation to whom the Kingdom would be given have to do that Israel did not? What would happen if no fruit was produced?

2) Read John 19:15 and John 1:29 – How should we understand what we see in these verses when we put them side by side?

a). Why is the Lord’s crucifixion so important to Israel?

3). Read Matthew 16:18 - What collective noun is given to the nation that would produce fruit for the Kingdom and what is important to know about this word?

a). So, where primarily is the 'Church' to be taken from and how would we know?

4). Read Genesis 1:26-28 – What first mention principle is set in place in these verses with respect to rulership in the stead of Satan?

a). What promise regarding rulership in both realms of the Kingdom had been given to Abraham?

b). All the descendants of Abraham through Isaac and Jacob were procreated so how could that established in Genesis 1:26-28 be applied to them?

c). Putting this together – What 3 things must be true for the nation that will receive the Kingdom of the Heavens rejected by Israel if they are to rule in that Kingdom?

5). What condition were we in at our natural birth and which verses did we look at that describe this for us?

a). In effect what did this mean for us?

b). What did we need to be delivered from for this condition to change and which verses did we look at that describe this change?

c). What does any individual have to do to become a part of the new nation?

d). Read Ephesians 2:4-9 - What do we learn from these verses?

e). Read Philippians 3:20 – What is significant about what we learn in the first part of this verse?

6). Which scriptures did we look at that show the 3 things necessary for rulership that we saw in question 4c have been accomplished?

a). Read Ephesians 2:14-16 – What do we see in these verses?
