Study Questions

1). Read Acts 1:4-11 – What command does the Lord give His disciples in v4?

a). What does the Lord say to them will happen 'not many days from now', and how many days was it?

b). Why do you think the disciples ask about the restoration of the Kingdom based on what the Lord had said?

c). What can we learn about the Lord's ascension from these verses and why are there 2 men in white apparel present as the Lord ascends?

2). Read Acts 2:1-4 – What is the sequence of events seen in these verses?

a). What is the immersion in the Spirit all about and how would we know?

b). What did the 120 do once they were filled with the Spirit?

c). Why did the Lord empower them to do this and which scriptures did we look at that show this?

3). Read Acts 2:12-21 – What does the Holy Spirit make clear the event those present in Jerusalem are witnessing is?

a). Read Joel Chapter 1 - What is this chapter about and what would be the key verses you would want to pull out of it?

b). Read Joel Chapter 2 - What is this chapter about and what is the context for the verses that Peter quotes from this Chapter?

c). Read Joel Chapter 3 – What is this Chapter about and what key verses would you want to pull out of this?

d). So, all in all, who and what does Joel's prophecy have to do with?

e). If those in Jerusalem had recognized what happened on the Day of Pentecost as the beginning of the fulfillment of Joel's prophecy, what would be the only conclusion they could come to?

4) Read Acts 2:22-37 – How can we explain Peter's ability to give a powerful sermon such as this?

a). What is the focus of Peter's message in these verses in Acts Chapter 2?

b). What question does it provoke and what is the answer given?

c). What do we know concerning the 3000?
