Study Questions

1). Read Acts 16:30 – According to what we saw in the scriptures on Sunday, what is the answer to this question?

a). Read Romans 6:30 – What does this verse add to our understanding?

b). Read John 19:30 – Explain the significance of what we find in this verse.

c). How free is the free gift?

2). Read 1 Corinthians 15:3 – What scriptures are being referred to in this verse and how would we know?

a). In what way is Christ's death presented in the OT scriptures?

b). Do we need to be able to understand the scriptures to be eternally saved?

c). Where did God begin His revelation to us?

d). Where did Jesus begin in order to reveal Himself to His disciples on the day of His resurrection?

e). Where did John begin his Gospel?

f). What do these tell us about where we need to begin to understand God's redemptive purpose?

3). Read Genesis 1:1-2a – what do we see in these verses?

- a). What did God not do in response to Satan's rebellion?
- b). So why does God restore the ruined creation as seen in Genesis Chapter 1?
- c) Read Genesis 1:2-5 – What are we taught in these verses?
- d). So, what does Genesis Chapter 1 teach us about God's redemptive process?
- e). What happened in the Garden with the serpent, the Woman and the Man and what are we to learn from this with respect to salvation?
- f). What happened to the restored creation as a result of the fall of Man and how is the creation inextricably linked to Man's redemption? [scripture would be good]

g). Beginning with Genesis 3:21 trace through the scriptures we looked at on Sunday showing what God reveals about the means of salvation?
