A Survey of the Bible – Lesson 13B  
'What Must I Do To Be Saved?'  
Study Questions

1). Read John 1:3-5 – What do we learn from v3 and what does this teach us about the 6 days in Genesis Chapter 1?

a). What do we learn from v4, what is the connection with Genesis Chapter 1 and with our own salvation experience?

b). What do we learn from v5 and how does this relate to our present experience as a saved individual?

2). Read 2 Corinthians 4:6 – What are the 2 aspects of the light seen in this verse?

a). The light shining out of darkness on Day 1 pictures our eternal salvation what does the light represent beyond that initial point with respect to the salvation of the soul and can you think of any scriptures to go with this?

3). Read Hebrews 11:17-19 – what can we learn from these verses about Adam and Eve’s experience with death and shed blood in Genesis Chapter 3, Isaac’s in Genesis Chapter 22 and our own?

4). What condition were the Children of Israel in prior to the Passover?

a). Where do we see this exact same picture presented in the foundation?

b). Read Exodus 12:3-7 – What was the solution for Israel’s condition?

c). What is the unchangeable process that we see set out in these verses?

d). How will this same process apply to Israel yet future?

e). Read Exodus 12:12-13 – Who was under the sentence of death and why?

f). What made the difference on the night of Passover between those who lived and those who died?

g). If an Egyptian had wanted to be saved that night what would they have had to do and which scriptures did we look at that show it to us?

h). How is this the same as our own experience?

i). What does God seeing only the blood teach us about the free gift?

j). Israel's deliverance from Egypt at Passover is more complex than just their escape from Egypt – what are the full ramifications of what took place that night and are there any scriptures to go with this? [something beyond 'yes' would be good]

k). What is the significance of resurrection with respect to the Kingdom of Christ?

5). Read John 3:14-15 – What is the last piece provided to that which began in Genesis 3:21?

a). Contextually, what are these verses dealing with and which scripture did we look at in connection with them?
