Study Questions

1). Taking the foundational process set out in Genesis Chapter 1 as our model-
What is our beginning point? [scripture to go with this]

What is the point of conclusion for us? [scripture to go with this]

What happens in between? [scripture to go with this]

2). How is the same foundational process set out in Genesis Chapter 1
repeated with respect to the Man and the Woman in Genesis Chapter 2?

a). How does that equate with our own experience as seen in the answer
to the previous question and which scriptures did we look at in connection
with this?

b). Who does all the work in building the rib into the Woman and what
do you think we should learn from this?

c). Thinking of God's work among the eternally saved to build the Bride for Christ – Is this random on God's part?

d). What is it then that determines who will be built into the Bride and which scriptures did we look at in connection with this?

e). How is this demonstrated through the type seen in Genesis Chapter 24?

f). Which verse did we look at that shows us this same thing in the Book of Ruth?

3). The foundational process that we see in Genesis Chapters 1 + 2 is repeated again in the Book of Ruth – Write down the scriptures we looked at from that Book that demonstrate the process.

a). What actions does Ruth take that demonstrate the present continuous part of the process?

b). What does this look like in our own experience and which scriptures can we look at in connection with this?

4). We see the foundational process seen in Genesis 1 + 2 and the Book of Ruth repeated again with the Children of Israel – How is this process presented with respect to the first generation to come out of Egypt?

a). With respect to the present continuous part of the process – what really significant ministry did God introduce in the wilderness journey?

b). What was this ministry primarily based on and what do you see as significant about this with respect to the Children of Israel?

c). Putting Genesis 1, 2, 24, Ruth and the Children of Israel together – Why do you think God repeats this process so many times and what do you personally learn from seeing it?

d). Read Matthew 16:13-27 – What do you see in these verses?
