2). The following questions are based on Matthew 16:13-27 -Read v13-16 – What is the context into which these verses must be placed?

a). What are the 2 statements that Peter made in response to the Lord's question and where did these statements come from?

b). What is significant about these statements and did Peter understand what he had said at the time?

c). What does the revelation of Jesus' identity teach us about the full scope of His ministry?

d). Now read v17-18 – exactly what is Jesus saying here and what is the connection with Genesis Chapter 2?

e). How is this inseparably connected to His ministry as High Priest?

f). Read v21 – Why does Jesus teach His disciples about His death and resurrection at this particular point in time?

g). Read v24 – Exactly who is Jesus talking to in this verse and what is He talking about?

h). What is the individual choice posed in v24 and where have we seen its parallel?

i). If we should choose to come after Him, how will our choice be proven?

j). What does it mean to deny our self?

k). What are the OT types that picture this for us and what should we learn from them?

l). What is the only way in which our self-life can ever be blessed?

m). Read Matthew 16:25 and Romans 8:13 – What do we learn from these verses?
