Study Questions

1). Jesus was born King of the Jews – how then should we understand His earthly ministry as Prophet?

2). Read Romans 8:19-23 – What do we learn in these verses about the Lord’s great redemptive purpose?

a). Look at v19 again. How is God’s redemptive process for fallen Man to be accomplished to bring about that seen in this verse?

b). Read Hebrews 2:3 – What is the ‘so great salvation’ and where in the scriptures do we first see it being spoken of by the Lord with respect to His Church?

c). Read Matthew 16:24 – What does it mean to take up our cross and follow Him?

d). Which verse did we look at on Sunday that presents the very same idea as that seen in Matthew 16:24?

e). Explain how these 2 verses parallel each other.

3). Matthew 16:25-26 provide the Lord's own commentary on v24 – how do these 3 verses fit together?

a). Read 1 Corinthians 3:10-15 – What is the parallel between these verses and Matthew 16:24-26?

b). Read Matthew 16:27-17:2 – What takes place in these verses and why are they important for the verses we have been studying in Matthew 16?

c). Read Colossians 3:23-25 – how does the reward of the inheritance and being repaid for doing wrong connect with the verses we have previously looked at?

d). How is this same thing presented in the Matthew Chapter 13 parables?

e). Read Matthew 16:26 again – Which 2 key words did we focus on from this verse and what do they have to do with?

f). What are we to learn from this verse and which OT character did we see referenced as having the correct scriptural attitude toward the salvation of the soul? [verses?]

4). Read Luke 19:12-13 and Matthew 25:14-16 – What do we learn from these 2 sets of verses?

a). Read Luke 19:15-17 and Matthew 25:19-21 – What do we learn from these 2 sets of verses?

b). What happened to the servant in both parables who made no profit?

c). How does that taught in the parables of the minas and the talents apply to our own situation?
