Study Questions

1). Read Luke 19:1-13 – Why did Jesus give the parable of the minas at this point in time?

a). Read Matthew 16:4-27 – Why can't we gain the whole world now and receive the salvation of our soul in the future? [Scripture we looked at]

2). Read Matthew 25:21 and Luke 19:17 – What do both these verses show and what is the greater context in which we need to place them?

3). Read Matthew 25:25 – What is the picture given to us by the servant hiding his talent in the ground?

a). What way is that pictured through the ground in which the talent was hidden described in the Matthew 13 parables?

b). Rather than profit and loss what terminology is used in the Matthew 13 parables?

4). Read John 12:24-26 – What do we learn from these verses?

5). Read Genesis 2:7 – What do we learn from this verse?

a). Read Genesis 17:1 – How does God describe Himself and what do we learn from this?

6). Read Ephesians 2:8-10 – What progression do we see in these verses?

a). By going back to the scriptures we have previously looked at, What are the 'good works' that we are to walk in?

b). Is walking in good works automatic upon our eternal salvation and how would we know?

c). Read 2 Timothy 3:16-17 – According to the beginning of v16, what is ‘all scripture’?

d). What does this tell us about the nature of scripture and which verse did we look at in connection with this?

e). What is the relationship between scripture and profit?

f). What is the relationship between scripture and good works?

7). Read 1 Peter 2:1-3 – What do we learn from these verses?

a). Read James 1:18 + 21-22 – What do we learn from these verses?

8). What then is the initial investment and how do we make a profit?
