Study Questions

1). Read 2 Timothy 3:14-17 – What is the exhortation that Paul gives to Timothy in these verses?

2). Read 1 Peter 2:1-2, Ephesians 4:11-15 and Hebrews 6:1-3 – In what way do these verses all connect with one another?

a). Read Ephesians 5:18-21 – What does it mean to be continually filled with the Spirit and why is this so important?

3). Read Romans 8:17 – What faith is spoken of here and what is the only way that this faith can be attained?

a). Read Hebrews 5:9-14 – What do we learn from these verses?

b). Read James 1:21- What do we see at the beginning of this verse?

c). What do we learn from the word translated 'filthiness'?

d). What do we learn from the words translated 'overflow of wickedness'?

e). Putting this together with the verses from Hebrews 5 – Why did those in Hebrews become dull of hearing?

f). What things did we look at that are examples of the ear wax?

g). Read James 3:14-16 – what additional insight does James give us and which other scriptures did we look at in connection with this?

4). Read Romans 12:1-2 – What do we see in v1 and how is it described?

a). What is the first command at the beginning of v2 and what do we know of the word 'conformed'?

b). What is the second command in v2 and what do we learn from the word translated 'transformed'?

c). How is the transformation to be brought about?

d). How is the renewing of the mind accomplished?

5). Look up the Greek word translated 'transformed' in Romans 12 and the Greek word translated 'transforms' in 2 Corinthians 11:14 – What is the difference and what might we learn from this?
