Study Questions

2). Read 1 Corinthians 9:24-27 – What would you say is the purpose for these verses?

a). What do you personally take from them?

b). What are the first 12 verses of 1 Corinthians Chapter 10 and what is their connection with the end of Chapter 9?

c). What do you make of v12 of Chapter 10?

3). Read Exodus 12:3 + 12-15 – What 2 interrelated commands do we see in these verses?

a). Which verses show us what Israel was promised if they did what God had commanded them?

b). Which NT verses did we look at that provide the Christian parallel to the Feast of Unleavened Bread?

c). What does v6b say to you?

d). How should we understand, ‘Therefore purge out the old leaven’?

e). Read 1 Peter 2:9-11 – Where have we seen that contained in v9 before?

f). What is the reason for abstaining from fleshly lusts and where have we seen this same thought previously?

4). Read 1 Corinthians 3:15-17 – How does v15 connect with what we have seen with unleavened bread?

a). What metaphor does Paul give in v16?

b). How would we defile ‘the temple of God’?

c). Read 1 Corinthians 10:3-5 again – What is the reason their bodies were scattered in the wilderness and which related Scripture did we look at?

d). Read Numbers 11:5-8 – What do we learn from these verses?
