‘The End of Your Faith’
Study Questions

1). Read Exodus 20:18-21 – What do we learn from these verses about Israel and God’s Word? [Pay particular attention to v19 and v21].

a). How is that which we see in the Exodus 20 verses portrayed in Numbers Chapter 11?

b). Thinking about the verses from Exodus Chapter 20 and Numbers Chapter 11 – what could this look like in our own setting? [look at this from the point of view of Kingdom believers, not Christians in a general sense]

2). Read Numbers 13:32 – 14:4 – From what we have just been studying, what is it that brought about the events seen in these verses?

a). Where do we find reference to this type of action in the NT and what would this look like in practice?

3). Read John 6:32-58 – What are we to learn from these verses?

a). Read John 6:66 – How does this connect with the verses we read from Exodus Chapter 20?

4). Read 1 Thessalonians 5:22 – What do we learn here about dealing with the leaven and which verses did we look at in connection with this?

a). Read Romans 7:21-25 – Thinking about the answer to the last question, what do these verses now picture for us?

b). According to v25, who is the only One who can deliver us from this body of death? [Lit. the body of this death]

c). How does the Lord deliver us from the body of this death and which 2 sets of verses did we look at that show this to us?

d). So, simply, in our own words – how do we keep the feast of unleavened bread?

e). Thinking about the unchangeable pattern of blood and leaven, how do we now understand that pattern to work?

5). Read Hebrews 3:1-6 [not in Sunday's message] – What do we learn from these verses and most particularly, what do you see in the second half of v6?

a). Read Hebrews 3:12-15 – What do we learn from these verses and how do they connect with what we have been studying in the last 2 weeks?
