Study Questions

1). Read Hebrews 2:5 – What exactly does this verse mean and what does it tell us about the Book of Hebrews?

a). Read John 18:36 [not in the message] – What connection do you see between this verse and Hebrews 2:5?

b). Read Hebrews 2:5-9 – What do we learn in these verses about the age to come?

c). What do you see in these verses about Christians in this present time?

d). Read Hebrews 2:10 – From what we see in this verse, why is it not possible for Christians to be ruling with Christ in this present age? [you could use other scriptures here in support]

e). Read Hebrews 2:16-18 – How does Chapter 2 of Hebrews end?

2). How does Chapter 3 of Hebrews begin and what does this tell us?

a). Read Hebrews 3:1-5 - What is our heavenly calling and what type is used to picture this?

b). Apart from our heavenly calling what is the focus of these verses?

c). Read Hebrews 3:5-11 – What does v6 tells us and how will it be possible for us to do this?

d). What do we learn from v7-11?

e). Read Hebrews 3:12-15 – What is the warning we see in v12?

f). What is the antidote to this seen in v13 and what does this verse say to you personally?

g). What do we learn from v14 and how does this verse connect with the verse before it and the verse after it?

h). Read Hebrews 3:16-4:3 – What essentially do we learn from these verses?

i). Read Hebrews 4:4 -7 – What do we learn here?

j). Read Hebrews 4:11 – What is our challenge in this verse and how will we accomplish it?
