Study Questions

1). To review again from last week – What can we know about those Christians who God will not permit to go on to maturity in the faith?

a). Read Hebrews 11:13-16 – What can we learn from the positive example given to us in these verses?

b). *once enlightened, and have tasted the heavenly gift, and have become partakers of the Holy Spirit, and have tasted the good word of God and the powers of the age to come, -* How does the experience of the first generation of Israel to come out of Egypt conform to what we see here?

c). How should Israel's experience have influenced their response to the 12 spies when they returned from spying out the land?

d). What was their response when the spies returned and where was their focus?

e). Why did God take this so seriously with respect to Israel?

f). Within our own setting then, why does God take this equally as seriously if we should do as Israel did at Kadesh?

g). Which examples and Scriptures did we look at with respect to turning back?

2). Read Hebrews 6:7-8 – Why are these verses here and what do we learn from them?

a). Why has the Holy Spirit been so diligent to present these warnings to us in Hebrews and which Scriptures did we look at in connection with this?

3). Read Hebrews 6:9-12 – Why was the writer of Hebrews confident of better things than that seen in the warning for those he wrote to?

a). *For God is not unjust to forget your work and labor of love* – the work and labor of love, where is the only place these can come from in order for them to have the value attributed to them?

b). What did this work and labor of love involve?

c). What must be the focus of this ministry to the saints and which Scripture did we look at in connection with this?

d). What do we need to understand about the love spoken of here and how is this accomplished?

e). Read Hebrews 6:12 again – What does this verse say to you?
