Study Questions

1). Read Hebrews 11:8-10 – What did Abraham do that he is commended for?

a). What does Abraham's action picture for us and what is the enormity of what this shows?

2). Read Genesis 12:3 and Exodus 4:22-23 – What do you think we are to learn from these 2 statements?

a). In the historical account in Exodus, what are the circumstances in which we see these 2 statements fulfilled?

b). Within Scriptural prophecy, when will we see these 2 statements fulfilled again and what will these events look like?

c). Read Zechariah 22:8 – What do we learn from this verse and how does it connect with the 2 previous statements we have looked at?

d). Which was the first nation to come against Israel after they had crossed the Red Sea?

e). Read Exodus 17:14 – thinking about what we have previously studied, why does God say this?

f). ‘Google’ the Amalekites and see what you can find out about them in history.

g). Read Matthew 25:31-40 – What is taking place in these verses and when will this happen?

h). What is the basis for the Lord’s decision in these verses?

i). How does what we see in these verses fit with what we see in Genesis 12:3?

3). Read Genesis 14:18-19 and Romans 4:13 – What do these verses have to do with Hebrews 11:17-19?

a). What commentary does Scripture give for God's statement, 'In Isaac your seed shall be called'?

b). How does this connect with the beginning of the Book of Hebrews?

c). Which other Scripture did we look at in connection with this?

d). What does all of this tell us about the picture given through the OT saints who follow on from Abraham in the second section of saints?
