Study Questions

1). What are the 2 diverging paths that Christians find themselves on and where do these 2 paths lead?

a). What does the Lord say about these paths in the Gospel accounts?

b). Which other scriptures did we look at in connection with this?

2). Read Revelation 3:5 – What is the 3-fold promise given in this verse?

a). What do we understand by being clothed in white garments and which Scriptures showed how important this is?

b). What is not contained in the Book of Life?

c). What is the only basis for judgment and why can our eternal destiny never be judged?

d). Read the last sentence from Revelation 20:12 – What is written in the Book of Life?

e). What other Books does the Lord keep?

f). What is the Lamb's Book of Life and how would we know?

g). The faithful Christian will not have their name blotted out of the Book of Life. What does this mean for the unfaithful Christian and why would this be so?

3). Read Matthew 10:32-33 and Luke 12:8-9 – According to these verses, what is contingent upon the Lord confessing the name of a Christian before His Father and His angels?

a). Read 2 Timothy 2:10-13 – What do we learn from v13?

b). What do we see in v12 with regards to the Christian's name being confessed or denied by the Lord?

c). So, putting together the verses from 2 Timothy, Matthew 10 and Luke 12 – what 2 things must be included in our works recorded in the Book of Life?

d). What does it mean to confess Christ before men?

e). According to 2 Timothy, why did Paul patiently endure and what does this teach us about our own patient endurance?

f). Read Ephesians 4:11-12 and Hebrews 10:10 – What do we learn from these verses? And which verses did we look at in connection with this?

g). What are your thoughts about your name being present in the Book of Life and the works recorded beside your name?
