Study Questions

1). Read Matthew 24:13-14 – What does v13 mean?

a). Who will preach ‘this gospel of the Kingdom’ and what ‘end’ will come?

b). What will conditions on the earth be like for the 144000 Jewish evangelists and which verse from Psalms did we look at in connection with this?

c). Read Revelation 20:4 – who are these? What connection do they have with the 144000 and why have they ended up in the heavens?

d). Which other verse did we look at that tells us how many martyrs there will be?

2). Read Matthew 25:31-34 – Who are those seen in these verses?

a). What can we now from these verses about the ‘sheep’?

b). What will be the basis for the judgment seen here and which verses did we look at that show us what this will look like for the sheep?

c). What can we know about the ‘goats’?

d). What will be the ultimate outcome for both these groups?

3). Read Genesis 11:7-8, 10:25 and 32 – what do we learn here?

a). Where did we find commentary on these verses and what more can we learn from the commentary?

b). Read Acts 17:26-27 – What other information do we find here to add to the verses from our previous 2 questions?

c). Read Acts 3:19-21 – What are the ‘times of restoration of all things’ and what will this mean?

d). What will God do with respect to the unsaved Gentiles following Armageddon and why will He do it?

e). Will the formation of the Gentile nations in the Kingdom look the same as it does today?

4). Read Romans 8:19-22 – How do these verses fit into the restoration of all things?

a). What did God do with the waters that covered the earth as He began the restoration seen in Genesis Chapter 1?
