Study Questions

1). Read Revelation 21:1-6 – What is significant about the final 3 words in v6?

a). What is it that will be done?

2). Read Revelation 22:1-5 – What is significant about the final sentence in v5?

a). Is there a connection between the end of 21:6 and the end of 22:5?  
And if so, can you explain why?

3). From the Scriptures, what can we know about any carry over of the overcomers' promises from the Millennial Kingdom to the endless ages?

4). Read Revelation 21:9-13 – What is the symbolism of the great and high mountain?

a). Where else have we see 'mountain' used as a metaphor for Christ's Millennial Kingdom? [Not in Sunday's message]

b). What is significant about the way the city is described in v9-11?

c). How many gates does the city have and is there any significance to them having the names of the 12 tribes of the children of Israel?

d). Is there anywhere in Scripture that might show us which names of the 12 tribes of the children of Israel would be over which gate?

5). Read Revelation 21:14-17 – What is significant about there being 12 foundations?

a). Why do the foundations have the names of the 12 apostles of the Lamb?

b). What do we learn about the physical structure of the city and what might this tell us about the size of the new earth?

6). Read Revelation 21:21-26 – What do we learn in v21 about the gates of the city?

a). What might we learn from each gate being described as one single pearl?

7). Read Genesis 1:14-18 – What do we learn in these verses about the sun, the moon and day and night?

a). Which other Scriptures, outside of Revelation 21, did we look at to see how the sun and moon are used?

b). Which Scriptures did we look at concerning the use of day and night?

c). Read Revelation 21:23 + 25 again – how should we understand what we see here?
