Study Questions

1). Read Exodus 10:7 – What is the collective effect that the plagues have upon Egypt? And which scripture did we see related to this?

a). What do these scriptures tell us about Satan's kingdom as a result of the opening of the 7th seal with the 7 trumpets and bowls?

2). Read Exodus 11:4-7 – What first mention principle is introduced in these verses and where do we see this principle in action elsewhere in the scriptures?

3). According to Exodus 12:3-7 – What was the difference that God made between Egypt and the Children of Israel?

a). Who, by way of review, died in Egypt the night of Passover?

b). Read Exodus 14:21-22 – Given the death that took place in Egypt, what is pictured in these verses?

c). That seen in these verses is symbolic for Israel on 2 levels – Explain the symbolism that we see.

d). Why was Israel able to pass through the Red Sea to come safely to the other side?


e). Read Exodus 14:27-30 – Given the death that took place in Egypt, what is pictured in these verses?

f). What happens to the Egyptians and why does it happen?

g). Looking at the events at the Red Sea for both Israel and Egypt, what do they teach us about what will happen to Israel and the Gentile nations yet future and what is it that produces these different outcomes?

h). If we apply this whole picture of Israel and Egypt, to the eternally saved and the unsaved, what can we learn?

4). Read Exodus 3:7-8 – Looking at these verses, what is God’s purpose for delivering Israel?



How do these connect with what we just read in Exodus 3:7-8?

a). What part does Passover play in this?

b). Is God’s purpose accomplished for Israel the moment they come out of the Red Sea? How do we know from the foundation that this could not be the case?

c). Read Exodus 19:3-6 – When does God say this? Why does He say it at this point? And what does it teach us about Israel’s experience from this point forward?

d). What is significant about v4 in relation to what we see in v5-6?

e). What is the first thing God wants Israel to be faithfully obedient about and where did we find this in the scriptures?

f). What is pictured in this Feast?

g). Why is Unleavened Bread associated with Passover rather than the Red Sea crossing?
