Study Questions

1). What is the genealogical route by which we get from Genesis 1:26-27 to the Exodus?

a). What is the purpose for the Exodus?

b). What is God's expectation of His people following the Exodus and how do we know?

c). How is the whole of Jewish history past, present and future, seen through the events from the Exodus to Jericho?

d). Read Exodus 19:8 – what is the people's response to that which God has said and where can we find a parallel to this for ourselves seen through Ruth and Rebecca?

e). What do the events of the Exodus and beyond picture for Israel and which verses show the significance of these events for us?

f). How does our experience, beginning with our new birth, find its parallel with the experience of Israel?

g). Read John 19:30 – What is significant about this verse for us and what does it make clear about our Christian life beyond this point?

h). What are the various ways in which our ‘journey’ is presented and how should we understand what this journey is?

i). What is the Lord’s expectation for us throughout our ‘journey’ and which scriptures did we look at?

2). Read Hebrews 4:2 – What do we learn from this verse?

a). Read Exodus 19:1-2 + 16 + 20 – What is significant about the symbolism used in these verses?

b). Read Exodus 20:1-6 – What is God doing in these verses [and those that follow] and why is He doing it?

c). Read Matthew 4:23-25 – How do these verses find their parallel with the symbolism we saw in the verses from Exodus Chapter 19?

d). Read Matthew 5:1-6 – What do we see in these verses [and those that follow] that parallel the verses from Exodus 19 and 20?

e). How do we know, from the scriptures, that the Jews of Moses day and the Jews at the Lord's first advent did not mix faith with what they heard?
