Study Questions

1). Read Exodus 19:10-11 + 20:1 + 13-14 and Micah 4:1-2 – How are these 2 sets of verses connected?

a). Which verses did we read that show us another foreshadowing of the event prophesied in Micah?

b). At the time that Jesus gave it, who was 'The Sermon on the Mount' for? And who is it for now?

c). Should we be looking for a 'mountain top' experience like Israel at Sinai, or at the mountain where the Lord gave His 'sermon', and how would we know?

2). Read Romans 10:17 and Hebrews 4:2 – how can we resolve the apparent contradiction between these verses and which scriptures did we look at that can help us with this?

a). Which verses did we look at that gave us an example of hearing, but not 'hearing', at the Lord's first advent.

b). Who was Nicodemus and what do we know about him from John Chapter 3?

c). What did Nicodemus have in his possession and what should he have done with it?

d). What does John 5:46 tell us about Nicodemus' situation?

e). Read Matthew 16:13-17 – How did Peter come by the declaration he made and did this just happen randomly?

f). What should we learn for ourselves from all this?

3). What scriptural way can we use to describe the events of Abraham's life from leaving Ur of the Chaldees to the command to sacrifice Isaac?

a). Why was the command to sacrifice Isaac Abraham's ultimate test of faith?

b). What scriptural way can we use to describe the events of Israel's journey from Egypt to Kadesh Barnea?

c). Read Numbers 13:1-2 + 17-20 – what do we see from these verses?

d). Read Leviticus 20:24 and Exodus 33:1-2 – Why did Kadesh Barnea provide the ultimate test of faith for the first generation to come out of Egypt?

e). What was the outcome of this test and which scriptures did we look at connected with this?

f). Which scriptures did we look at that show the same thing seen with the first generation repeated at the Lord's first advent?

g). Read Hebrews 4:1-11 – what do we learn from these verses and which scripture did we look at in conjunction with these?
