Study Questions

1). Read 1 Corinthians 10:1-12 – In these verses we see that there are 5 specified actions listed on Israel's part that provide examples that we should not do. Below these 5 actions are listed – Our task is to find where these actions are recorded in Moses writing and then to say what these actions would look like for us – you might want to add some scripture for this part as well.

[Helpful hints – Look at what Corinthians says were the consequences of these actions to help you locate them. You could use cross-references or word searches. You will find what you need in Exodus and Numbers]

b). The overcomers' promises in Revelation Chapters 2-3 – are they all or nothing and what will be the determining factor?

3). Read Genesis 24:10 + 53 – What is going on in these verses and why?

a). What connection is there between what we see here in Genesis Chapter 24 and the 12 spies going into the land at Kadesh Barnea?

b). Read John 13:1-3 – what is of particular note at the beginning of v3?

c). Does this connect with anything we see in Genesis Chapter 24?

d). Read John 16:13-15 – What should we particularly note about the work of the Holy Spirit seen in these verses?

e). Read 1 Corinthians 2:6-13 – what connection is there between these verses, what we read in John 16 and Genesis 24:53 and Numbers 13:17-20?

f). What warning do we find in Hebrews 6:4-9

g). What do we know about the present inhabitants of the Kingdom of the Heavens from Ephesians Chapter 6?

h). What should our attitude towards this be and do we have any scriptures to back this up? [If so, what are they?]
