

Study Questions

1). Read Numbers 14:1-4 – Let's follow this through the scriptures –



a). Read these verses concerning Esau again – Do you see any connection between these verses and the 5 examples from 1 Corinthians 10 we studied last week?

b). Read Genesis 2:16-17 – Can we see any connection between Esau and the bowl of stew and the 5 examples from 1 Corinthians 10 and what we read here in Genesis Chapter 2? Can you explain the connection?

c). Taking all these things into account, what does despising our birthright look like from a Christian perspective? And can we find 3 scriptures that warn and/or encourage us with respect to this?

2). How does Moses describe what the Lord had done for Israel in Deuteronomy Chapter 4?

a). Read Ephesians 2:11-12 – How does Paul describe what God has done for us and what has made this possible?


b). If we should choose to be like Israel at Kadesh Barnea, how does the Book of Hebrews describe God's reaction to us?

3). Read Deuteronomy 4:25-31 – Look particularly at verses 29-31-

b). What does this phrase refer to?

c). Look at this same phrase in Numbers 24:12-17 – Who is speaking and what is he speaking about?

d). What does God also say to Moses about the One who is the ‘Star’ to come out of Jacob?

e). Why does Moses speak about things ‘in the latter days’ to the second generation of Israel and can you find a verse from Hebrews Chapter 4 that shows the reason for this?

f). What types do we see in the second generation at Jericho?
