Study Questions

1). Read what the Lord said to Solomon in 2 Chronicles 7:19-22 – how do these words apply to Israel in their past, in their present and in their future?

2). In your own words give a brief outline of Jewish history that brought them to the time of the Babylonian captivity.

3). Read Jeremiah 29:10-14 – Which of these verses apply specifically to the Babylonian captivity and which are speaking prophetically of a yet future day? Why would you say so?

4). Read Daniel 9:1-2 – What did Daniel do, as recorded in these verses, and what did he conclude from doing it?

a). What had Jeremiah said in the verses of his we have already read that caused Daniel to start praying?

b). Which other verse from 2 Samuel Chapter 7 would Daniel have had in mind when he started to pray?

c). Which verses did we read that show Daniel's prayer?

d). What exactly was Daniel expecting to happen at the end of the 70 years of captivity and where was the foundational pattern for this set?

e). Why did God send Gabriel to Daniel and what did Gabriel tell him?

5). Read Daniel 9:20-27 – Exactly what is set out in v24?

a). What then is contained in the verses that follow v24?

b). Read Jeremiah 33:17-21 – What does the Lord tell Jeremiah in these verses?

c). Where do we find God's covenant with day and night?

d). Keeping all this in mind, who would the 'Most Holy' and 'Messiah the Prince' in Daniel Chapter 9 be?

f). When do the 490 years begin to be counted from and where do we see it in the scriptures?

e). According to our verses from Daniel Chapter 9, what would happen at the end of 483 years and what does this mean?

f). What then must take place during the last 7 years of the 490?

g). Make a list of all the reasons why we know that these last 7 years have not been fulfilled yet.

6). Which other scriptures did we look at that also talk about 'Messiah the Prince'?
