Study Questions

1). Read Genesis 1:1-3 – What was the purpose for God's action seen in v3?

a). Looking at v1 – Why do you think the heavens are mentioned before the earth in the creation and do we have any scripture for this?

b). Read Genesis 3:15 – What is the full extent of what is promised in this verse?

2). On Day 6 in Genesis Chapter 1 why was Adam [and the Woman] created?

a). Moving on 2000 years who do we come to and why do we come to him?

b). Read Genesis 14:18-19 + Genesis 22:17-18 – What is the promise given to Abraham and his descendants?

c). Read Isaiah 43:1 [not in the message] – What do you see in this verse?

3). Moving on from Abraham – To whom was the earthly realm of the Kingdom covenanted and what promise was made to this individual?
[Scriptures would be nice]

a). Looking at the verses we had on Sunday – What did the prophets have to say about David's promised Son?

b). Read Galatians 4:4 – How are we to understand 'the fullness of the time' and which scripture would we go to, to see it?

4). Why is there nothing else written in the scriptures beyond the end of Malachi Chapter 4 until we get to the Gospels?

a). What does the word 'Gospel' mean and what does it not automatically mean?

b). So, what do you think the 'Good News' presented by the Gospel writers is?

c). How does John's Gospel differ from the other 3 Gospels?

d). What is the parallel between the beginning of John's Gospel and that which Moses wrote at the beginning of Genesis?

e). Read John 20:30-31 – What is the stated purpose for the 8 signs recorded in John's Gospel?

f). Who were these signs for and how would we know?

g). What were those given the signs to believe and what would be the outcome for those who did believe?

h). Why does none of this have anything to do with eternal salvation?
