Study Questions

1). Read Matthew 15:24 and Jeremiah 50:6 – By explaining the symbolism we see in Jeremiah, how should we understand the phrase, 'the lost sheep of the house of Israel'?

a). How is this situation described in Jeremiah replicated at the Lord's first advent and do we have any scriptures that show this?

b). So, given the message, 'Repent for the Kingdom of heaven is at hand', keeping in mind what we have just looked at, what was the nation to repent from?

c). Read Revelation 2:4-5 – What similarities do you see in these verses with what we saw in Jeremiah 50, and at the Lord's first advent?

d). Which scripture did we look at that describes our high calling?

e). Read John 10:1-6 – What do we learn from these verses?

f). Read John 10:11-16 - What do these verses add to what we have just studied?

g). Read Luke 15:1-7 – What are these verses about and what do we learn from them?

h). Read Matthew 7:15 and Acts 20:29 – What connection do we see between these 2 verses and what should we learn from them for ourselves?

2). Read Mark 1:14 – What appeared to have ‘gone wrong’ at the start of the Lord’s ministry and what action did this cause John the Baptist to take?

a). Read Isaiah 53:2-6 and Psalm 2:6 – What 2 facets of the Christ do we see in these verses?

b). What had already been laid out in the scriptures that had foretold of the suffering servant?

c). What would we know from John 1:29?

d). Read Acts 2:22-23 and Revelation 13:8 – What do we learn from these verses?

e). Read Matthew 16:13-21 – What 2 things are introduced in these verses that became the Lord's central focus? Why was this?

f). In which other chapters of Matthew did we see 'the Church', without that name being used?

g). Where do we see 'the Church' laid out for us in the OT scriptures?

h). Read Luke 13:6-9 – What do we learn through these verses?
