Study Questions

1). What is the focus of all Scripture and what would this tell us about the Lord's death and resurrection?

a). How do we know this to be true from the Book of Hebrews?

2). Read Isaiah 52:13-15 – What does v14 tells us about the extent of the Lord's physical suffering and what was the response of those who saw Him?

a). How will things be different in this same location when Christ comes in His Kingdom?

3). Thinking about the Lord's crucifixion – Why is this important for Christians?

a). Why is the Lord's crucifixion important for Israel? [Think carefully about this one]

4). What is the connection between the Lord's resurrection and Day 3 in Genesis Chapter 1?

a). Read John 13:3-9 – What do we see in these verses about the Lord's resurrection?

b). Read 1 Peter 1:3-5 + 9 – How have we come to the living hope?

c). Who is the living hope and how would we know?

d). What is the hope that we have?

e). Read Genesis 14:18-20 – What do these verses have to do with the Lord's resurrection?

5). Read Romans 6:3-9 – What are we to learn from these verses?

a). Looking at the imagery of baptism in these verses, where in foundation MUST this take us and which scripture have we looked at in connection with this?

b). What did we look at on Sunday concerning the experiences of the first generation of Israel after the Red Sea crossing and what should we learn from this concerning ourselves?

c). Read 1 Peter 1:6-9 – What are we to learn from these verses about our present and our future?

6). Read Philippians 3:8-11 – What do we learn from these verses, especially with regards to resurrection?
