WHY COUNT

Data collected on bicycling and walking will assist City and leaders with estimating usage and demand for bicycle and pedestrian facilities. The counts will also be used to track the city's progress on increasing the use of non-motorized transportation, strengthen grant applications to leverage additional federal funding for bicycle and pedestrian projects, evaluate existing projects, and help determine the location of future investments.
