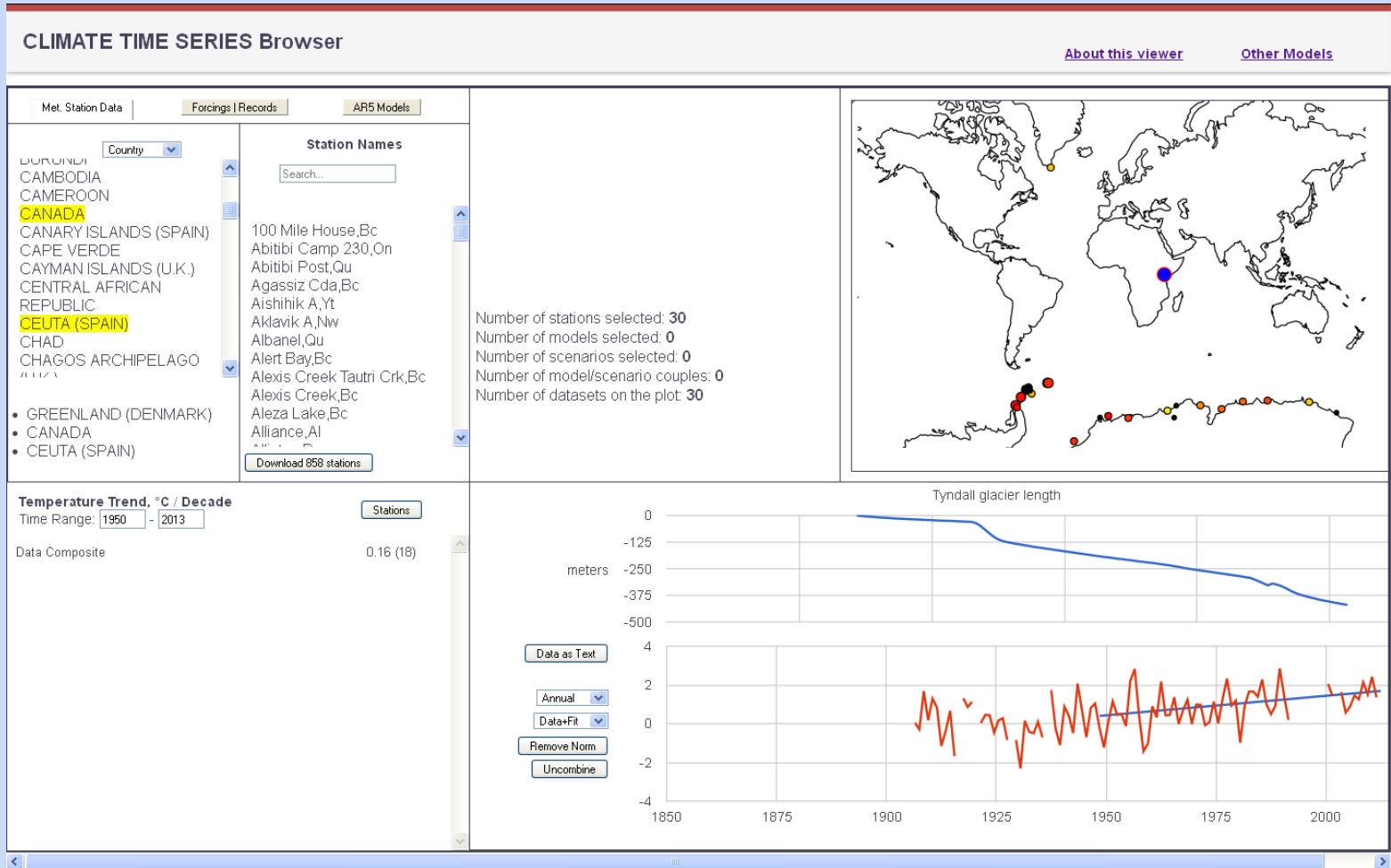


Antartica contains 90% of the world's ice

Greenland, by contrast, has only 4%, and the rest of the 6%. I decided to create a model that has reporting from stations that are in proportion to the world's ice.

This is the '90% Antarctica' run:
