The Glam. But I must be careful, lest I get purple boils spelling the word "SNEAK" on my face... This is just an excerpt of the assignment (the whole thing is 140,000 words long, some of it in Thai, plus several more images).

Here is some feedback to the assignment I did (including the parts not shown):

Your main ideas are clearly stated and you have given appropriate, relevant supporting examples. Well done. Regarding the additional comment, though it is possible for the attacker to pick up something JINXED W/ SPELLS, this is very unlikely to happen in our case.

Again, your main ideas are clear stated with appropriate supporting examples and evidence. Another thumbs up for you. Apparition is a magical skill that requires the user to concentrate his/her mind continually upon reaching their destination. Doing it unsuccessfully would result in splinching. And I think, the murderer's mind is highly disturbed by the fact that he/she had committed a murder crime and it would not be possible for him/her to apparate. Also, as you can see, the hole on the broken window is quite small for an adult to pass through and therefore using a broom to escape the building via the broken window is not feasible. However, I appreciate your additional comment as it is very entertaining.

Your ideas are correct. I believe Killing Curse is a very powerful curse whereby casting it would not only break the window but also destroy that part of the room. And the victim must have been very lucky to be able to escape from the first attempt of the Killing Curse.

In Singapore, the normal room temperature is around 25-29 degree Celsius and it is very unusual for the room temperature to be lower than 10 degree Celsius (Not even with the air-conditioner running). However the eyewitness is indeed an unreliable part of the case and therefore I give you 27 points on this. P.S I could not read Thai, hopefully it is not a part of your answer.

The author's thoughts are very difficult to understand. I was really not able to know what exactly the author wants to do and how. I would need much more details to evaluate better and it would be good if the details are in lines with guidance provided by the course instructors. At present, I am feeling really sorry to give low grades to the author.

You should just skip the peer assignment!

Selection of items are quite correct but missing symmetry symbols. Missing specific cropped image of the particular pattern on the item. Poor description of the design but good explanation of the function. Too much irrelevant information and please use the given template. Nevertheless, good effort.

you did not positioning of symmetry symbol for rotation ,reflection

The first question, for reflection only, saw the object of either fork or spoon being chosen. It has a vertical mirror reflection when we view it at the front. And in this case, the correct symmetry operator was identified, however, the symmetry operator was not placed on the picture itself hence unfortunately not all marks are awarded. Moving on to next picture, we have the tiles with the unique flower pattern on each tile and when 4 tiles are placed together forming a large square, it does shows a 4-fold rotation. However, apart from that, mirror lines are also present.

And this would not show the rotation only aspect. The symmetry operators, again in this case was not shown, hence not all marks are given as well. Coming to the last picture, we have chopstick being chosen to represent the rotation plus reflection. With the base of the chopstick being identified, this object would be a relatively good choice in showing the above-mentioned symmetry type. However, again, no symmetry operators were chosen to place on the picture itself to show the type of symmetry operations. Hence, unfortunately, only certain amount of marks are awarded instead of all marks.

Overall, -1: Not using the template and not labeling the object with symmetry elements -1: The image of the object that she wanted to portray was not shown fully (i.e the image of the spoon and for the chopsticks, if he wants to show that the square base of the chopstick has both reflection and rotation, he should take photo of the square base and not like what he had shown) and thus, I had to imagine the image that he wanted to portray through his text. Reflection only: In text, she said that the mirror plane is right in the middle of the fork/spoon which is correct. Supposedly 6 marks would have been awarded for that but she did not use the template nor did she took a full image of the object. Rotation only: She identified the correct object as when the 4 tiles are placed together, there are no reflection lines, only 1 4-fold rotation which she had identified in text. Supposedly, she would have gotten full marks but unfortunately... (Refer to reasons for marks deduction above) Rotation and reflection: She did not show which part of the chopsticks she was referring to but from her text, she meant the square base of the chopsticks. One mark was deducted as she did not identify the type of symmetry operation that the object can undergo. Actually, the square base of the chopsticks can undergo reflection operation as well as a 4-fold rotation. It has 4 identical mirror lines.

Hi Patchareeya, here's a brief overall comment: - Did you not receive the memo to complete the assignment on the template given? Because this has hindered the presentation of your answers, which were correct but not adequately demonstrated and explained. The tools in the template would have benefited you greatly! - You also gave more than one answer per question which was unnecessary (and incompletely described, too). - One more tip on answering questions: there is no immediate or conscious facilitator in this online course but it would be nice to observe professionalism nevertheless - less digressions and being clothed would be highly appreciated. Otherwise, I do believe you have a good command of the content, but the presentation has indeed let you down.

This lesson plan is well-designed. I could really imagine the lesson procedure. Keep on being creative!

I do not understand the lesson plan. It is somehow unclear. The section of alternative assessment is missing. The steps of the procedure are not coherent .I am sorry for saying my opinion frankly.

First of all, I had lots of difficulties analyzing this plan as the students and setting were not clear. It's really confusing. Besides that, are these students learning Thai or English? Also, in my opinion, the procedures should be more detailed. I could not visualize what was supposed to happen in the class. I'm awfully sorry, but as far as I understood this participant asked me to evaluate his/her essay. I think I'm not supposed to that.

It is certainly a great paper. The format could be a bit clearer. But the overall job is really impressing.

The author was able to follow all the requirements needed in this Lesson Plan project. However, I think this lesson Plan is made to cater Thai students based on the objectives: C. LEARNING OBJECTIVES/EXPECTED RESULTS: By taking into account Bloom's taxonomy and having in mind that levels might overlap and do not necessarily have to used in order during instruction, the following objectives can be outlined: REMEMBERING: Firstly, students will name appearance-related vocabulary from a given picture and secondly students will have to recognize/identify the correct definition for a given word. UNDERSTANDING/APPLYING: Students will exemplify and use their knowledge to describe people's appearances. There is no rule but inserting something to maintain communication flowing. ANALYZING/CREATING: Students will freely structure/produce questions and answers to describe people. Creative sentences are welcomed but not mandatory. By the end of the lesson, learners will be able to: - listen to and understand Thai at a natural speed. - ask and talk about everyday things in Thai. - They will review, use, and practice vocabulary and language in general in Thai. That being said, this Lesson Plan will not be that helpful for ESL students.

Dear colleague, I am sorry to inform you that your submission may have been done in a hurry and you did not have time to check what you were sending. First, you clearly say that your students are months old up to three years old and then you describe university classes Second, The background explains what you did in the past but does not say how it connects to the near

or long term of your class. Third, your objectives are jumbled between "appearance" and what struck me the most was that your objectives clearly state students will be producing in Thai! Please remember this is about teaching English. The list of materials is there, but it does not connect to the contents of the lesson. Specially the puppets have no use in a class where your students are only answering a worksheet and discussing it. Your procedures list only a series of activities that test students in the most positivistic ways. Remember we are teaching English using the most constructivist approach and communication is key. This only meant that you missed all the objectives of this module. There was not any trace of alternative assessment or class management that stimulates learning English in that classroom. Finally you did not write a reflection that includes suggestions from phase one. Probably the peer coach did not even read your work or you would have realized this. I am so sorry. Probably the most striking part of your plan was the picture of the humming bird but that was all. cheers.

This lesson plan did not adhere to the the modules covered through out the topic and what was expected, with regards to individual learning differences, alternative assessments and classroom management were missing. Furthermore, there was no reference to the changes from the first lesson plan carried out and how the new topics were included.

The activity is rich and detailed, although it does look like it was copied out of a book. The instruction section is completely irrelevant and could not be scored.

I didnt get the instructions rather a random photo of the teacher? The Guernica is a serious artwork and one I have used with year 6 students and they made movies explaining the artwork after they drew it and viewed some interpretations of it on You Tube which gave some historical and social context. They also learnt about Picasso and they shared their work online. You haven't really catered for different modes of expression. Annotating with a stylus is a good idea though.

I wish that the instructions were more clear, the piece you have chosen is such an important piece when discussing war, a topic that is so important right now.

I like your project idea and that it can be carried out in a computer lab. This activity would also give the students a chance for peer grading, which I think is a good exercise at junior college level. With this kind of serious artwork, I think one could also add a sound track to the activity. You chose a fantastic work of art to go with the theme. Creating the lesson for common screens and tablets is a great and very adaptable idea. It would even appropriate for smartphones and social media as an expansion and opportunity for "group-think". The outline could benefit with more specific instructions regarding the expectations of the writings completed by the students. I also thought of the Blind Contour activity as a great way to have the students contrast their use of words and also help illustrate the technique that Picasso seems to echo in this particular work.

This was imaginative, well-written and organized.

I have given you a score of 5 because, although I did not particularly enjoy the reading (I found it dark and depressing as a choice), it is still well written, very detailed and informative. You are obviously an expert in your chosen field. However, the description of the image and it's historical background takes about 90% of the article. I do feel that it would have been more effective to have used the image to present the required topic of Expertise. Instead it felt more like a History lesson. Yes, I know your field of expertise is History, but the topic of the assignment is still Expertise. However, this is not why I graded you with a 5. My grade has more to do with how I experienced the article and whether or not I learned more about the topic - Expertise - and because there was so little of an argument put forward with regard to the topic, I did not learn much and could not clearly see the connection or relevance. Also, as a matter of courtesy, I would have appreciated more consideration from the writer. To flood the text box with a whole lot of irrelevant information, i.e. previous drafts and feedback, and the plea for support in something completely un-connected to the assignment. Wading through all of this material was such a waste of my time and certainly did not add to my experience of the work submitted. It in fact detracted from it. As you prepare for Project 3 please do have more consideration for the people who are to review or assess your work. Thank you.

"Never underestimate the power of a simple declarative sentence." LESS is MORE. I don't think Glam has a place in Scholarly writing and asking for higher marks plus 50% was very unprofessional. The actual essay wasn't so bad and that ALONE would have given you at least a 3, because you still didn't include an argument, citation or pose a question. But your rambling will cost you points. Sad but true. This could have been a really classy piece.

You might consider Submitting the assignment only in the format suggested within the word limit range suggested. You might consider an explicit argument; This is an image that represents the expertise of a painter. OR This is an image that represents the expertise of a historian. OR whatever. You argument was not clear to me. The image represents what expert? An expert painter, historian, what/who? If the image represents war, then you may have misunderstood the assignment. "War" is not an expert. Please consider using future writings to improve your writing, including instructions such as "Please grade me according to either my Glam or the actual essay, whichever scores higher. Oh yes, and add 50% to THAT score when you give me my grade." give the impression that you are taking the course for points, not for self-improvement as a writer in conventional, standard English.
