## ROMANS: PART 4 EXPLANATION OF THE GOSPEL

God's Righteous Condemnation of the Pagan (1st message)
"What About Those Who Have Never Heard?"
Romans 1:18-23

## REVELATION: All People Clearly **Know** That God Is There. 1:18-20.

- 1. This revelation is a universal revelation of God. Vs 18. "men" = all people.
- 2. This revelation is a *clear* revelation of God. Vs 19. "evident" ( $\phi \alpha \nu \epsilon \rho \sigma \sigma$ ) = plain, manifest.
  - -He is evident within them (internally).
  - -He is evident to them (externally).
- 3. This revelation is a natural revelation of God. Vs 20. "through what has been made."
  - -Creation is a glorious theater that points to God. Ps 19:1-6; Job 38:15-17.
  - -Creation is a clearly visible (kata + horao =  $\kappa\alpha\theta$ o $\rho\alpha$ o) pointer to the invisible (a + horao =  $\alpha$ o $\rho\alpha$ to $\sigma$ ) God.
  - -Creation: "what has been made" = poiema,  $\pi o i \eta \mu \alpha$ , poem. It's a piece of art. Hence an Artist!
  - -He is evident "out there" in the macro-world & micro-world. (Cosmology & providence).
  - -He is evident "in me" in my body, soul, conscience. (Epistemology, Axiology, Teleology, etc.)
- 4. This revelation is a <u>constant</u> revelation of God. Vs 20. "for since the creation of the world" -It is not now & then. It is always there.
  - -It is not here & there. It is everywhere.
- 5. This revelation is a universally perceived revelation of God. Vs 20. "clearly seen"
  - -Every person knows God exists -- deep inside they know.
  - -Every person does not know God in a saving way.
  - -But every person does *know* Him to be a reality (no "pink elephants").
- 6. This revelation eliminates excuses. Vs 20b.
  - -The excuse would be ignorance. No one can claim it.
  - -They may have never heard of Jesus Christ, but they did know God -- and rejected Him!

## REJECTION: Lost People Suppress the Knowledge of God They Know Is There. 1:18.

- 1. Lost people "katecho" (κατεχω hold down, hold back, restrain, repress, suppress) the knowledge of God.
- 2. Lost people suppress this knowledge because they do not want the true God! Rom 3:11; 8:5-8.
  - -The problem is moral not intellectual. "In unrighteousness"
  - -The problem is they do not like God. They are ungodly (anti-God), unrighteous (anti-good).
  - -The problem is they hate God:
  - Sovereignty: Ps 2 (CF I Chron 29:10-13). I don't want Him running my life.
  - Holiness: Isa 6:1-5; Hab 3:16; Job 42:6; Lk 5:8 (Cf. Rev 4:8). He is Other than me, He's holy. Omniscience & Immutability: Ps 139. He *always* sees me. He will *never* change.

## REPLACEMENT: Lost People Exchange God for "gods" they invent in their Own Image. 1:21f

- 1. Alternative religion is not a product of people seeking God.
- 2. Alternative religion is a product of people rejecting the knowledge of the True God.
- 3. The universal reaction to God is Idolatry!
- 4. No one sincerely seeks Him in their own way...
- 5. Rather they sincerely turn from Him to something else (though their idols are made of clay).
  - -They make an intentional theological shift, because the True God is repugnant to them.
  - -They trade God in for something less sovereign, infinite, majestic, holy.
  - -Their new religion can be formal: animism, polytheism, pantheism, existentialism, naturalism, nihilism, secular humanism, agnosticism, atheism, etc.
  - -Their new religion can be informal: sports, music, art, things (Mammon), etc.

CONCLUSION: It is not too late return to the One True God.
