"A Final Warning & Promise" Romans 16:17-20

Paul's Warning In Context.

Jesus & Paul understood that the Church will always struggle with division & attack from within.

- 1. Jesus: The Gospel causes division. Mt 10:34. False teachers will come. Mt 7:15-16; 24:5,24.
- 2. Paul: The Gospel causes division. I Cor 11:18-19. False teachers will come. Acts 20:28-30.

Paul's Warning. Rom 16:17a

- 1. The command: (σκοπεω, skopeo) keep your eye on, Be on the alert for, Watch out for.
- 2. Those who cause divisions.
 - They do so by introducing a slightly different Gospel (a false one)
 - They do so by presenting an unbalanced view of Christianity.
- 3. Those who put obstacles ($\sigma \kappa \alpha \nu \delta \alpha \lambda o \nu$, skandalon) in others way
 - They do so by immoral behavior (Hence, scandal)
 - ◆ They do so by adding to the Gospel. Mt 23:4-5;13

Paul's Test. Rom 16:17a

- 1. The test: Whatever is contrary to (along side of) the teaching (lit. doctrine) you've received.
 - Whatever is contrary to the Apostolic faith & practice. Jude 1:3.
 - What ever is contrary to the historic conservative Protestant faith & life.
- 2. Some examples¹:
 - Special revelations. Robert Tilton, Pat Robertson.
 - ♦ We become little gods. Paul Crouch, Casey Treat, Kenneth Hagin, Morris Cerullo
 - Christ merely human. Kenneth Copeland.
 - ♦ A limited God. Kenneth Copeland, Fred Price.
 - ♦ A Gospel of Wealth. Fred Price, Robert Tilton.

Paul's Evaluation Of The False Teachers. Rom 16:18

- 1. Their motivation (Cf. Phil 3:18-19; Jude 1:12-13):
 - They are slaves to their own appetite (financial gain, fame, or power over others)
 - ♦ They are angels of light. II Cor 11:14.
- 2. Their methodology:
 - ♦ They appear to be sincere in speech. *Smooth*.
 - They *flatter* their hearers. Their speech that is kind, loving, merciful, easy to bear.
 - ♦ They deceive the *unsuspecting* (I.E. the naive).

Paul's Command. Rom 16:17b,19

- 1. He calls us to turn away from them, stay away from them. II Jn 1:9-11
 - He does not call us to have heresy trials & burn the heretics.
 - He does not call us to debate them.
- 2. He calls us to be wise in what is *good* & *innocent* (lit. pure) in what is evil. Cf. Mt 10:16-17.

God's Promise. Rom 16:20

- 1. This looks back at the beginning when the 1st Gospel was given after the Fall. Gen 3:1-5; 15
 - ♦ Satan tempted them: (1) not to believe God & (2) the knowledge of good & evil
 - ♦ The result of the fall: a continual enmity between Satan & God's people.
- 2. Satan will soon be crushed under your feet. Gen 3:1-5; 15
 - ♦ The God of peace will crush him. He is the One who does it. He est.'s peace.
 - ♦ Satan will be crushed under your feet. Thru the Gospel (Rev 12:11) & holy living.
 - It will happen soon. It occurs now through Gospel faith & Gospel living.
