

SUMMARY OF CLASS Life in Christ is all about relationships, with God, others and ourselves If we reduce Christianity to a series of steps for handling life better, then we miss the whole point of the gospel Our value is rooted in His undeserved love (We are chosen – Eph. 1:4-5) Our purpose is to give others a taste of God's goodness that points them to Christ (Luke 9:24). Our hope is being with Christ in a future day when every relationship will work exactly as designed (1 Peter 1:3, Rev 21:4)

- Empathy begins with these three principles

SUMMARY CONT. GOD HAS DESIGNED US TO RELATE IN THESE WAYS

- To HIM by developing a confidence in His goodness. Because He's good, that enables us to trust Him no matter what happens or how we feel
- To OTHERS by giving ourselves away for Christ's sake with an energy that longs to see the same confidence in God grow in others (interpersonal)
- To OURSELVES by enjoying our unique dignity as men & women, who because
 of God's wisdom & kindness have something to give away that is useful for
 good purposes (intrapersonal)

SUMMARY CONT. LIVE FOR OURSELVES OR GOD'S GLORY • Devote the majority of our energies to overcoming our difficulties so that we can enjoy our life again and feel happy • OR • Be more concerned to trust God in the midst of our problems so that we can better reflect His glory and serve His purposes
