- In this true story, God, by the power of His Word, made the world in six days.
- If you had a chance to talk to an animal God created, what would you want to find out?
- Each day of this week, search the Internet for the NASA picture of the day. Then say together, "O LORD, our Lord, how majestic is Your name in all the earth!" (Psalm 8:9).
- God created plants for food. Talk about which plants are you favorite to eat. Do you know which plants animals eat?
- Fruits and seeds go together. As a family, talk about how many seeds are in certain fruits. Then, explore the idea of how many fruits might be in a single seed.
- Pray with your family and thank God for something special in His creation.

Genesis 1:26–2:25

- In this true story, God made people in His image, provided for their needs, and made them rulers over the earth.
- Sometimes, the Garden of Eden is called Paradise. It was the perfect home for Adam and Eve. What do you like about the home God has given you? How is it a gift to you?
- Adam named all the livestock and birds. What is one of your favorite animals?
- Ask each person in the family to tell about a special outdoor area, park, or garden. Find out what makes that place special. Together, thank God for His lovely outdoor spaces.
- Pray together as a family, and ask God to help you enjoy and care for all of His creation.
