Numbers 13–14

- In this true story, the people of Israel grumbled. They did not trust God to take care of them. But God forgave them and kept His promise to give them the land of Canaan.
- The spies spent forty days exploring the Promised Land. Count ahead forty days. Where you will go between now and then? What will you see? What will you do? Will God be with you?
- Ten of the spies were afraid to enter the Promised Land. Talk about your fears. When does being afraid prevent us from doing good things?
- Play the game I Spy. What good things do you see? Pray together and give thanks to God for His good gifts.

Joshua 3:1–5:12

- In this true story, God led the people of Israel out of the desert and into the Promised Land.
- God commanded that the people build a memorial with stones to remember His grace and power at the Jordan River. What memorials have you visited? Build a memorial to remember what God has done for your family.
- God led the Israelites to a new land. Have you ever moved to a new place? Do you know someone who has moved away? Write a letter or an email to someone you know who no longer lives close to you.
- Pray together: **Dear God, keep those safe who have moved away. Help them to make new friends and to know You will always take care of them. Amen.**
