



The Wisdom of Solomon

1 Kings 3

- Use the web or a map to identify the names of the roads and streets near your house. If you were going to the grocery store, which ways could you go? Some people think there are many ways to heaven. Read John 14:6. How would a wise person answer that thought?
- Talk about the good dreams you have had. God spoke to Solomon in a dream. How does God speak about His Good News to you?
- Let each person in your family look at the front of this card and tell others one thing he or she notices. How is God at work in this story?
- Let each person name or show something you can use to measure. Then read 1 Kings 4:29–30. What would you use to measure Solomon's wisdom?
- As a family, pray that God would grant leaders wisdom.





Solomon Builds the Temple

1 Kings 5–6

- As a family, work together to build something while one person reads the Bible story.
- Solomon built a temple. You can build too. Build your spiritual muscles by reading God's Word. Build your physical muscles by using hand weights or resistance bands. As you work out, repeat this week's Bible Memory Verse.
- It took seven years to build the first temple in Jerusalem. Calculate how old each family member will be in seven years. What do you think God will help you accomplish in seven years?
- Take time to organize tools in the garage, basement, or kitchen. Talk about how you use each tool. How does God build faith in His children? What tool does He use?
- As a family, pray that God would build each person's faith.
