John 2:1–11

- In this true story, Jesus did His first miracle at a wedding. Talk about what has happened at the weddings you've attended. Was Jesus there?
- Tell about a miracle—one for each letter in Jesus' name.
- Jesus turned the water in six large stoneware jars into premium wine. How is water used during the church service? How is wine used?
- The servants filled jars of water when Jesus asked. Fill cups with water at your next meal. As you pour the water, ask God to bless the person who sits in that spot.



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Jesus Clears the Temple

John 2:13–22

- In this true story, Jesus got rid of things in the temple that did not help people worship.
- Try the art of stacking twelve plastic cups. On five cups, write the letters **JESUS**. As you practice putting them up and taking them down, think of what Jesus said. Although His body, the temple, would be destroyed (taken down), it would also be raised up in three days!
- Draw crosses on liquid soap containers. When you wash your hands, remember that Jesus' sacrifice cleanses us from all sin.
- Take a photograph of your church. Put the picture on your refrigerator. Ask God to bless what happens there.
- As a family, pray and confess your sins to God; He can cleanse you from unrighteousness (1 John 1:9).
