Acts 2:1–21

- In the catechism, we learn that the Holy Spirit does work we cannot do by ourselves. He calls, gathers, enlightens, and sanctifies the Church and keeps it with Jesus in the one true faith. Make up actions to express those words.
- Red is the color the Church wears on Pentecost. Enjoy an enriching red fruit smoothie. How does the Holy Spirit enrich your life?
- On Pentecost, the Holy Spirit appeared as tongues of fire. Name other Bible stories that include fire.
- A big noise filled the city of Jerusalem on Pentecost morning. What big noises have you heard lately? What did they mean?



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Peter and John Heal the Lame Man

Acts 3

- This week, your child learned that Peter and John met a lame man (the word *lame* means he wasn't able to walk) sitting at the gate of the temple. Through God's power, the lame man was healed and the two disciples preached about Jesus.
- Each day, put your hands on your diaphragm. Breathe in through your nose. Breathe out through your mouth. Say, "The Church inhales God's mercy; it exhales His love to others." How did God's mercy come to you today? How does His mercy come to others through you?
- When healed, the lame man leapt for joy. Name good things God has done for you. Try leaping and clapping at the same time.
